OPPORTUNITIES TO MAKE A DIFFERENCE

LEGISLATIVE REVIEW BOARD (October thru January, up to 4 hours per month, up to 40 positions available) Legislative professionals and public policy college students can connect with a club or YMCA to review bills and proposals for their content and feasibility, better preparing our delegates for success and deepening their efforts to form simulated public policy.

LEGISLATIVE EVALUATOR (November 18, 55 positions available, 9:00 am-3:00 pm)

Evaluators score delegates in committees or serve on a select panel to determine outstanding chair and clerk teams during our District Conference on November 18 at Duncanville High School. Morning and afternoon shifts are no more than 4.5 hours. Evaluators also help identify award winners, as well as outstanding speakers and debaters who fit criteria for Conference on National Affairs. Training will be provided.

JUDICIAL COACH (October thru January, up to 20 hours per month, up to 10 positions)

Attorneys, Judges and law students can connect with a club or YMCA in need of professional preparation for trial or moot court teams. Teams prepare for District Conference in November, State Conference in January and if they advance, National Judicial Competition in summer.

PRESIDING JUDGES—Trial and Moot Court (November 18, possible 10 positions available, morning/ afternoon shifts or all day) Though students typically preside in the courtroom, we may need adults to fill this role if we do not have capacity during our District Conference on November 18 at Duncanville High School. Morning and afternoon shifts are no more than 4.5 hours. We will provide you with the case and procedure, along with training prior to conference.

JUDICIAL EVALUATOR (November 18, possible 10 positions available, morning/afternoon shifts or all day) Evaluators score mock trial and moot court teams on November 18 at Duncanville High School. Morning and afternoon shifts are no more than 4.5 hours. Training and lunch are provided.
